

El Arbol de Familia Español I Señora Sousa

Overview:

You will be putting together a family tree using a Web 2.0 tool (online program) called Myheritage.com.

Task:

You will create a family tree of images, birth dates, and other factual information using the website www.myheritage.com.

1. Generation Requirement
 - a. Three generations of family members to include:
 1. Grandparents
 2. Parents and their brothers or sisters (if applicable)
 3. Siblings (if any)
 4. 10 family members total
2. Include the following three facts for each family member.
 - a. Family member's full name
 - b. Age of each person
 - c. One line description of each person using adjectives

***All facts must be written in Spanish**

Procedures:

1. Logon to www.myheritage.com
2. Click on the Sign up button in the upper right hand corner of the screen

3. Fill in the required information to create an account. *Make sure you use an email address and password that you will remember.*
4. Click on **Skip all Offers** on the bottom of the screen
5. Fill in the information about you and your parents (with your mother's maiden name)
6. Click on **keep free plan**
7. Start working on your family tree
 - a. To add grandparents, click on your mom and/or dad's name

- b. Names of people will appear on the left side of the screen. This is where you will add photos and factual information. Remember to add their birthdays, wedding date, occupation, nationality, etc.
8. When you complete your family tree, you can print it by clicking the **print chart tab**
 - a. Type: **All in one**
 - b. Orientation: **Vertical**
 - c. Generations: **Always**
 - d. Personal Photos: **Always**
 - e. Photo size: Small
 - f. Facts: **Custom>All Facts>**choose all the facts you included in your family tree by **clicking on the fact** and the **Add** button in the middle.
 - g. then click on **generate chart** on the bottom
 - h. Chart style **Show** (customize your colors)
 - i. Fonts: chart elements>hold the shift key down and select all of the choices (title, names, fact labels, fact text and footer), choose the font you like
 - ii. Background color – pick a desired color for the background
 - iii. Frame – choose a desired frame
9. Click on **Generate Chart** then check your email or refresh that page
 - a. Under chart name, you should see your name, when the chart was generated and the chart actions. You want to click on **VIEW**. When the chart opens up in a new browser window, print your chart (make sure everything is on there as stated in the directions above)
